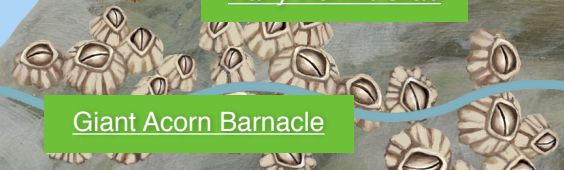
## Splash Zone

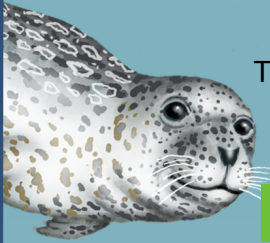

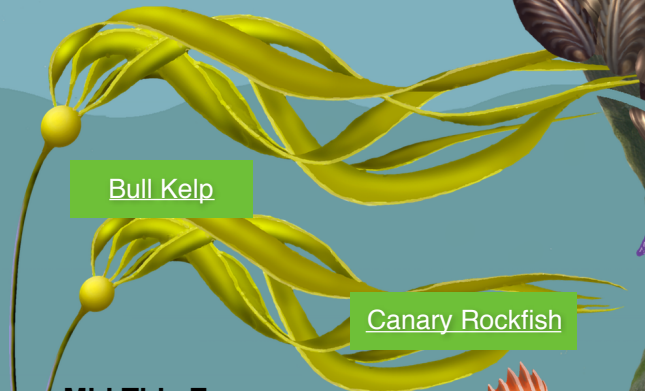
